At the meeting there are several important subjects to discuss with you.

- Ongoing waterfront projects and in particular the appeal which we have lodged in the Environment Court opposing Variation 11. Since December, we have had one further meeting "without prejudice" with our lawyer and two members of the City Council.**
- The City Council's plan to review the Waterfront Framework, which it adopted in 2001. We have told the council that any review should not be finalized until a decision on our appeal has been issued. We have asked to have representatives on any review team, and we've said any review should include full public consultation. Waterfront Watch was represented on the "leadership group" which wrote the Framework, and we believe it has performed well and is not in need of reviewing.**
- Council consultation. In March we had a meeting with the Mayor, Celia Wade Brown, Councillor Pannett and a council officer with regard to improving this.**

We know from your feedback that we have your support in continuing to defend Wellington's beautiful waterfront and protect it for future generations.
